

Lifegroup Discussion Questions  
Forgotten Virtues Part 6: Purity

**Note to lifegroup leaders:** *Given the sensitive nature of this week's message, I would strongly encourage your group to sub-group during the discussion if it is a couples or mixed company group. Have the guys break in one room and the women break into another room. This will create a safer environment to promote more open discussion.*

**Getting Started:**

1. Share with your group one way God has made a difference in your life this past year.

**Digging In:**

1. Read 2 Corinthians 7:1; 1Thessalonians 4:3,7; and Hebrews 13:4. What do these passages teach about purity?
2. *Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-20.*
  - a. What do these verses teach us about the significance of our sexual purity to our relationship with God?
  - b. What does this passage communicate about the positive and negative effects of choosing to live a sexually pure life?
  - c. What are ways that people experience troubles in their relationships today as a result of choosing to not live a sexually pure life?

**Making it Personal:**

In his message Pastor Greg said that we could pursue purity by:

- a. Considering our relationship with Jesus
- b. Drawing near to Jesus and receiving his forgiveness
- c. Renewing our minds (Psalm 119:9)

1. What step toward purity do you need to take this week?
2. How can those in your lifegroup encourage you as you take a next step?

**Prayer:**

Take a few minutes to pray for each other that God would help you to live a life of purity allowing you to grow in your relationship with Him and others.
